

## Summer 2024 Class 3 - What are we learning this term?

#### **Maths**

#### **Statistics**

We are refreshing our understanding of how to draw, read and interpret line graphs, as well as deepening our understanding of bar charts, pie charts and averages.

#### Shape

In this unit, we will be looking at our understanding of angles, including how to measure angles and draw them and calculating with angles in a triangle and quadrilateral.

## Fiction: A mythological narrative

## Non-Fiction: Writing a newspaper article

We will look at examples of local and national newspapers to build our understanding of writing in a journalistic style.

## Poetry: Writing a Cinquain.

A cinquain is a 5 lined poem that follows a specific syllabic layout – we will choose a topic we enjoy and write several cinquains.

#### Music

We will be exploring 3 different topics using our music curriculum-'Race', 'Exploring identity through song' and 'Ame sau vala tara bal'. The children will focus on creating music to accompany a short film, exploring themes around identity, as well as aspects of lyric writing and expressive singing to convey mood and emotion.
