### **Muslim Visitor Returns**

On Wednesday, 25th September the children in Class 2 and Class 3 welcomed Mr Kotwal to our school to deliver an interesting workshop giving a valuable insight into what it truly means to be a Muslim in Britain today. This experience not only deepened our understanding of the rich culture and profound religious beliefs associated with Islam, but also enriched our knowledge with a wealth of fascinating facts. The children had the opportunity of trying on traditional Muslim attire, showcasing the diversity of clothing styles across different cultures. Mr Kotwal also brought a selection of artefacts with him and explained their value and meaning within the Muslim faith. A highlight of Mr Kotwal's visit was when he provided us with a comprehensive virtual tour of the interior of a mosque, highlighting the significance of various architectural elements and explaining the meticulous preparations Muslims make before engaging in prayer. This glimpse into the sacred space further deepened our understanding and appreciation for Muslim practices. At the end of the sessions the children were given picture worksheets to colour in highlighting the key areas of Mr Kotwal's visit.

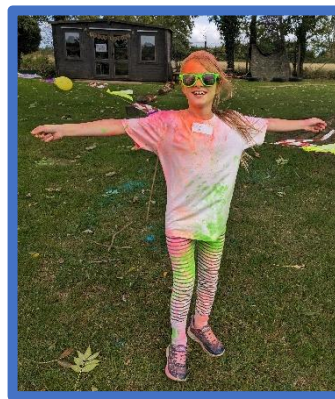


Mr Kotwal praised how knowledgeable and attentive the children were and how welcoming they all were.

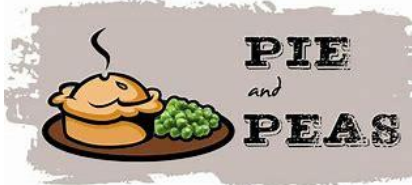
### PTA Halloween Disco

### **Important Uniform Reminder**

The governing body has a statutory duty placed upon it to ensure that school policies promote good behaviour and discipline amongst the pupil body. We believe that a smart school uniform worn by all children will promote a sense of purpose and discipline which is the foundation for both personal and academic development. Moreover, it contributes to a sense of community and belonging, central to our ethos, as all our children identify with each other and the school. Could we please ask families to ensure they are following our uniform policy which can be found on the school website:-

Our uniform requirements are:-

- Navy blue or white, plain or embroidered\*, polo shirt (For pupils in Nursery and Reception, a white polo shirt or shirt is not recommended due to the nature of the messy activities in school. It is suggested that pupils in this year group only wear the navy blue)
- Navy blue plain or embroidered\* crew-neck or V-neck jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan.
- White short or long-sleeved school shirt or blouse.
- In warmer weather, a light or dark blue gingham check dress, shorts, skirt or a tank top style jumper.
- Grey, black or white socks, grey or black tights.
- Plain black school shoes or plain black trainers, sensible school-style sandals in summer, with no heel. We do not have school pumps. Black school boots are acceptable in winter; parents may wish to send indoor shoes if the child would find it uncomfortable to sit on the floor in these, if bulky or wet.
- A pair of wellingtons, named and with a peg, for access on the field in wet weather.

\*Where reference is made to 'embroidered', it refers to an item of uniform that has been embroidered with the school logo badge. The school logo badge is the property of the school and should not be copied, without express permission of the school.

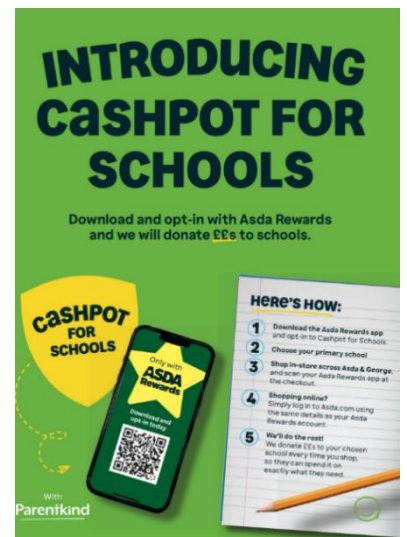
### Easy Fundraising
