This Term In Class 3

In writing this term we will be reading lots of exciting fiction and non-fiction including:

Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo

The Arrival by Shaun Tan

Our first text this term will be *Beowulf* by Michael Morpurgo. We will discuss legends and folklore, the importance of heroic poetry in early European literature and write recounts, formal letters, dialogue, descriptions and finally will write our own epic, heroic narrative using various poetic devices. The outcome will be to write a missing chapter of Beowulf or an own version of a legend.

In our guided reading lessons this term we will be reading:

On The Move: Poems About Migration by Michael Rosen
 Decl. Life Mustering by Green Martin

Real-Life Mysteries by Susan Martineau

We will learn about all the mysteries a theories regarding the Loch Ness \mathcal{O} Monster, Bigfoot and UFOs. This book allows readers to study the amazing evidence about these mysterious cases and make up their own mind as to what is real, and what could be fake. The class will continue to work on all the skills they use during guided reading such as inference, prediction and looking at vocabulary.

> In maths this term we are primarily learning about ratio, statistics, algebra, shape, converting units and position and direction. We will be practising: ratio and proportion language; revisiting different types of graphs; how to work out the angles in different shapes such as triangles and quadrilaterals; converting miles to kilometres, kilograms and kilometres, looking at imperial measurements; quadrants, coordinates and translation . We use White Rose Maths resources and questions to ensure children understand each small step of learning

before we move on.

Science

RE

This term in Science we will be learning about Evolution & Inheritance – changes over time, offspring, adaptations, evolution, skeletal changes. Class 3 will continue to work on studying scientific data and present findings, as well as using evidence to support ideas.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be looking at relationships. Focuses will be on why mental health is important and how to stay safe online.

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In the second half term, we will be learning about how our bodies change, self image and the year ahead.

Art

Computing

Our computing topics this term are programming and AI.

Programming will help the class to programme games and as well as debugging computer programs. We will then be learning how AI can be used and how it is trained using machines.

Music

Our Music learning this term involves learning about Baloo Baleerie. It is about one of the most ancient types of song – the lullaby. We will explore lullabies from across the globe, learn about 3/4 time, as well as sing and play this beautiful lullaby from the Shetland Islands.

French

PE

French this term will continue to build upon prior learning. Our topics are 'At School' and 'Vikings' - we will be practising our oral, reading and writing skills.

After Easter we will be having swimming lessons every week for the first half term. After half term we will be practising our athletics, running and performance techniques ready for sports day!

Our RE in the Summer

term will focus on Christianity. We will be considering, 'what would Jesus do?'
