We are now able to confirm the staffing arrangements for the next academic year which will be upon us in the blink of an eye!

Class 1

Nursery, Reception, and Year 1 children, will be led by Miss Northway, supported by Miss Ducat, Mrs Bowmer and Mrs Russell.

Class 2

Mrs Olot will return to headship in Africa at the end of July, therefore Class 2, our Year 2,3,4 class, will be led by Mrs Lindley, supported by Ms Lamb, until Mrs Morton returns from her maternity leave, which we anticipate being after Christmas.

Class 3

Our Year 5 and 6 class, will be taught by Mrs Winder as she completes her teacher training, supported by Miss Langhorn. She will continue to teach the class when Mrs Lindley returns to Class 3, teaching 2 days a week to allow Mrs Lindley her deputy headteacher leadership and planning time.

Mr Jones will be leaving the school at the start of July as he is relocating to Shropshire. We would like to thank him for his time at the school and wish him well in his new role.

Sports Day

Mrs Hall will host our Sports Day on Monday 21st June. It is fantastic that all of our children across the school are able to participate in Sports Day again, albeit in a socially distanced way. It is a shame that parents and carers are not able to attend this year due to social distancing, which has been the same for professional sportspersons until recently. However, we are a step further forward than we were last year at this time, so please take comfort from this and we hope and pray that you can all join us next year.



The children will be given a chance to shine out on the sports field and will have a fun, lively and energetic afternoon participating in running, egg and spoon, obstacle, beanbag in the bucket and throwing activities, as appropriate to their ages. Mrs Hall will ensure that the children enjoy participating in the activities and they will be encouraged to take part in new events. Holiday Club

Having consulted with staff, we have made the decision not to offer a Holiday Club in summer. The Holiday Club was offered last year to support parents who were keyworkers having to work through lockdown and also to offer some respite to parents whose children had been learning at home since the March 2020 lockdown. As we have now been back in school since March, our staff who have been working hard since the initial lockdown to teach both children in school and at home are ready for break themselves.

School Meal Price Increase



Our school meals are good value for money but even they are likely to increase in line with inflation and the cost of living. From September the cost of a school meal will be £2.75 per day or £13.75 per week.

Non-Uniform day supporting Childhood Tumour Trust.

On Friday 28th May we had a non-uniform day to support the Childhood Tumour Trust. They offer support for children and their families affected by Neurofibromatosis (NF1), a genetic neurological disorder that can affect the brain, spinal cord, nerves and skin. We raised £47.50. Thank you to everyone who donated. There is still chance to donate via ParentPay if you have not already done so.



Sun Cream

The weather has finally perked up and the sun cream has been in use this last week! However, please remember that the Sun Cream letter clearly explained that all children should have sun cream initially applied at home before the school day begins and school ONLY tops up the initial application during the school day. Thank you for your cooperation.

Pastoral Support

Mrs Thornton has added the attendance grid (click on the link below) for your information, giving tips for boosting and maintaining your child's attendance. With the prospect of an uninterrupted half term



ahead, we are all aware of the importance of attendance for the children's progress and attainment. We strive to achieve at least 96% attendance across all our classes within the White Rose Federation. If your child's level of absence concerns us or attendance falls below 92%, you will be contacted by the school to look at what support can be offered to improve attendance. We want to work with you to ensure we give your child the best opportunities to grow and succeed.

Pupil absences



It is really important that you please make sure you telephone or email the school before 9.15am to notify us of any child absence, with a reason for their absence, even for Nursery children. Equally, we ask if your child is unwell and you have called on the first day of their absence, we also require a call on **each subsequent day** until they are well enough to be back in school. If we don't receive any communication, by phone or email, we start our process of contacting all of the contacts allocated to your child and if we still haven't received any information, the Children Missing in Education protocol is triggered. Thank you for your cooperation with this.



Outstanding ParentPay debts

Across the federation, there is an agreed maximum debt per child, which is £30.00. This includes any nursery fees, school dinners and out of school club payments. Please keep an eye on your child's account and make payment as soon as possible, thank you.



Medicines in school



If you require your child to have medicine administered during the course of a school day, please complete a 'Parental Request for Medicine in School' form, available from the School Office and the school website. We are not allowed to administer any medicine without this being completed fully and signed by a parent/carer and the Headteacher/Head of School. If your child requires a course of antibiotics for example, over a period of a few days, please ensure that the medicine is handed directly in to the School Office each morning. Whilst we can administer Calpol (or similar Paracetamol-based medicines), we are not insured to administer any Ibuprofen medication sent in, unless this is prescribed by a doctor.

Car Park reminder

When parking in the Community Hall car park we ask that all families reverse park into the spaces as this gives better visibility when moving around. Now that Miss Hannah is back in the Community Hall for dance lessons, could we please remind families not to park in her reserved space on the days listed on the sign.
