The Lodge

It's nearly time for the Young Voices concert at Sheffield Arena! The t-shirts were sent home this week and we are expecting the delivery of parent tickets next week. The children will be travelling on a coach, leaving just after lunchtime on Tuesday 7th January 2020. The children spend the afternoon rehearsing the songs and then eat their pack up for tea. The suggestion from school is that each child has a hot school lunch before departing and then brings a pack up tea and a drink in a named disposable bag. They will need to come to school dressed in their Young Voices t-shirt with their school jumper or cardigan over the top and will need a coat. They should wear black or grey trousers or leggings and comfortable shoes.

Parents are to make their own way there, ready for a start time of 7.00pm. Please be aware that the area around the arena does get busy and to allow plenty of time to get there and park.
