Out of School Club

Thank you to all our families who support our Breakfast and Out of School Club; we hope the facilities we have in place go some way to helping you with childcare before and after school.

In response to a request from a parent, we have considered the times we serve food at our Out of School Club and will be making some changes effective from Monday.

Our Out of School Club Leaders, Miss Langhorn and Mrs Harrop, will begin preparing the food with the children from 4.30pm so if you are collecting your child at the end of the first session at 4.25pm, please may we kindly ask that the collection is prompt so that the leaders have time to prepare food and feed all our hungry children! If your child is staying for the second or third session and you would like them to have the light tea, then please do not collect before 5.00pm in case they are mid-tea. Likewise, if you would prefer for your child not to have the tea and only access the childcare provision, please let the office or the OOS Club leaders know.

Uniform

Please can you ensure your children are wearing the correct school uniform. Oversized bows, themed headbands, nail polish and trainers are starting to sneak themselves into school again. Lovely though they may be, they are not school uniform and there have been some broken and damaged items as part of the wear and tear of the school day.

Girls are permitted to wear their hair down, but they must have a bobble in school and be able to tie their own hair up for PE.



Outstanding payments on ParentPay

Please could parents and carers ensure that any outstanding ParentPay debts are cleared before Wednesday 23rd October? Across the federation, there is an agreed maximum debt per child, which is £30.00. This includes any school dinner, trip, and out of school club payments. Within ParentPay there is the facility to pre-load your Parent account with a credit balance, in order that you can make payments for items in advance. To do this, just select the payment item and choose how much you would like to add. The cash will be debited from your bank account at that time but will sit within your ParentPay credit balance to be debited each time your child has a lunch or attends an Out of School Club.

Please note that you will need to apply online for secondary school places by the 31st October 2019. This date falls over half-term, so this is the last opportunity for school to remind you of the deadline.
