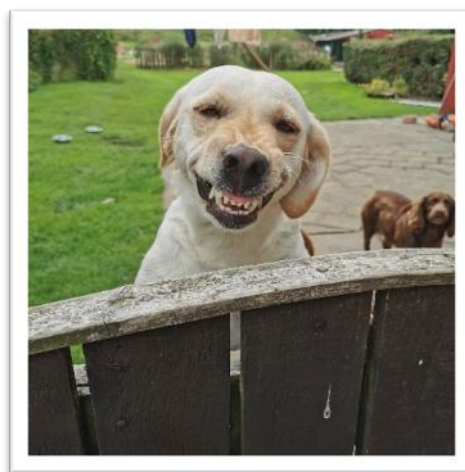
### Twig's Winning Smile
